Ballinderry Practice Day, 12th April 2026 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

TORC MOTORCYCLE CLUB will host the Ballinderry Enduro/Practice Day on the 12th April 2026 starting at 11am and finishing at 15:00 from Ballintombay Wood.

PERMIT. Held under permit from the MCI (SC) Ltd., (permit No. TBA), under the General Competition Rules and standing regulations for ENDURO'S of the MCI.

ACCESS. Start Area will be at Ballintombay Wood, Ballinderry Co. Wicklow. Google Maps coordinates 52°56'51.4"N 6°16'45.1"W See www.tour-ireland.ie for B&B's

ENTRIES should be made on line via the TORC website. www.torcireland.ie . Entry fee is €60 and will close at 8pm on Saturday the 11th April. **There will be no entry on the day.** Entries are limited to 120 riders. All riders must hold a current National license issued by the **MCI** - OR - their own National License with a starting permission issued by their National affiliate of the **FIM**. (FMN) Start Permissions Must be submitted for authentication 14 days prior to the closing date for entries.

REGISTRATION and TECHNICAL CONTROL. Sign-on will be open from 08.45am. **Sign on will close at 10:30am.** Riders must present their motorcycles for inspection between **9:00am and 10:30am** on the morning of the event. Riders briefing will be at 10.45, **ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.** Each machine must be in accordance with article 140 of the GCR'S of the MCI and comply with the standing regulations for Enduro's of the MCI. A noise test may be carried out in accordance with technical rules (96db). The RIDER will be asked to present their helmet complete with a current MCI helmet stamp. Tires must be FIM approved for Enduro use and E marked.

COURSE will be forest tracks, some "fire road" and open Mountain. There will be no limit to the amount of laps as its only a Practice Day

PETROL: There will be a refueling point. **NO PLASTIC PETROL CANS.** Any plastic fuel cans found at the refueling point will be removed prior to the event start.

VOLENTEERS: Any rider (or riders support crew) abusing a volunteer before, during or after the event will be subject to disciplinary action as laid out by the MCI General Competition Rules. It is hard enough to get voluntary helpers to run events for you, so please always respect them. If you have an objection to any aspect of the event, please direct it in the appropriate manner to the Clerk of the Course or MCI Steward.
