SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

TORC MOTORCYCLE CLUB will host Round 4 of the Irish, Torc and Vets over 50's Enduro Championship on the 6th of September 2026, starting at 11am in Ballinascorney Upper Wood.

PERMIT. Held under permit from the MCI (SC) Ltd., (permit No. TBA), under the General Competition Rules and standing regulations for ENDURO'S of the MCI.

ACCESS. Start Area will be advertised through TORC Facebook/website. See www.tourireland.ie for B&B's. Coordinates are 53°12'51.5"N 6°23'56.2"W

ENTRIES should be made on line via the TORC website. www.torcireland.ie. Entry fee is €95 and will close at 8pm on Thursday 3rd September 2026. There will be no entry on the day. There will be a limit of 125 entries. All riders must hold a current National license issued by the **MCI, MRA** - OR - their own National License with a starting permission issued by their National affiliate of the **FIM**. (FMN) Start Permissions Must be submitted for authentication 14 days prior to the closing date for entries.

REGISTRATION and TECHNICAL CONTROL. Sign-on will be open from 08.45am. **Sign on will close at 9.45am**. Riders must then present their motorcycles for inspection between 09.00am and 10.15am on the morning of the event. Each machine must be in accordance with article 140 of the GCR'S of the MCI and comply with the standing regulations for Enduro's of the MCI. A noise test may be carried out in accordance with technical rules (96db). The RIDER will be asked to present their helmet with a D strap. Correct eye protection must be worn at start of the race. Tires must be FIM approved for Enduro use and E marked.

TIMING, will be carried out by RFID. Wristband must be collected after sign on. And returned after the Event.

STARTING ORDER, will be in compliance with art.062.34 First bike will depart @ 11.01am.

COURSE will be forest tracks, some "fire road" Open Mountain, and public roads. There will be a number of laps of approximately 45km long. There will be ONE "ET" (Enduro test) per lap and one free run through will be at the C.O.C.'s discretion. There may be a via check per lap, also will be at the C.O.C.'s discretion.

PETROL: There will be a refuelling point. **NO PLASTIC PETROL CANS**. Any plastic fuel cans found at the refuelling point will be removed prior to the event start.

PENALTIES will be in accordance with Art.062.64. No tear offs for goggles are allowed, due to the obvious litter they cause.

VOLENTEERS: Any rider (or riders support crew) abusing a volunteer before, during or after the event will be subject to disciplinary action as laid out by the MCI General Competition Rules. It is hard enough to get voluntary helpers to run events for you, so please always respect them. If you have an objection to any aspect of the event, please direct it in the appropriate manner to the Clerk of the Course or MCI Steward.
